Admission: Accelerated International MBA Program



To be considered for admission, all applicants **MUST** provide all required material as outlined in this form. Completion of the admission file is the student's responsibility. A completed admission file must contain the following documentation:

1. Application Form

The application form must be legibly completed (preferably typed) signed and dated. All accompanying materials should be typed and signed.

2. Fee

Each application for admission must be accompanied by U.S. \$30 in the form of a check or money order payable to: Long Island University. The application fee is not refundable or transferable.

3. Transcripts

Two official transcripts are required from each college or university attended, at both the undergraduate and graduate level, whether or not the applicant earned a degree. To be considered official, transcripts must be sent directly from the issuing institution to the Graduate Admissions Office. Unofficial student copies or transcripts not sent directly from the institution will not be acceptable.

4. Letters of Recommendation

Two letters of recommendation are required. The most helpful evaluations demonstrate an awareness of your management potential, academic performance, and extracurricular or community performance.

5. Graduate Management Admissions Test (GMAT)

All applicants must take the GMAT test prior to being considered for admission as a full-degree candidate student. Only scores received directly from the Educational Testing Service (ETS) are acceptable. Unofficial examinee copies of score reports will not be acceptable. If you took the test more than five years ago, you must take it again. Any questions about the GMAT should be directed to GMAT, ETS, P.O. Box 6103, Princeton, NJ 08541-6103.

6. Test Of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL)

The TOEFL is required of all applicants whose native tongue is NOT English. This requirement may be waived for those who have a college or university degree from an institution where English is the language of instruction.

7. Personal Statement and Resume

A written personal statement as well as a resume are required of all applicants. You may discuss your professional objectives, any significant professional or academic achievements, instances where you have successfully demonstrated leadership abilities, or anything else you think we should know.
