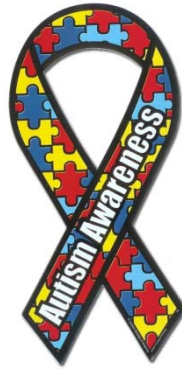


AUTISM COURSE AND WORKSHOP
