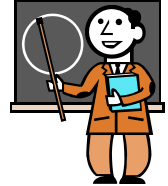

**Accelerated Teaching Certification Program in *Childhood Education***

**2007-2008**



**1-2-3 TEACH leads to a full-time teaching position in a high-needs elementary school in as little as eight months and a masters degree in education by the end of twenty months. Only a small number of very well qualified and highly-motivated students are accepted into this program. Among the requirements for this program are: successful completion of the LAST\* by the end of Spring '07 and completion of major prerequisites by the end of August, 2007. (Degree to be completed by August, 2008.)**
