TWO WORKSHOPS ON STRATEGIES FOR INTEGRATING POETRY THROUGHOUT THE CURRICULUM

Session 1 • Mon. 2/4. 4:30-6pm

Poetry workshop for elementary teachers Workshop participants will be introduced to and write list poem and epistle poem related to a science and/or history subject they have been exploring in class. Participants will also work with a partner to create a found poem on a science or other topic, a lesson they can replicate in class with small groups. Time permitting, participants will write cinquains.

Session 2 • Mon. 2/11, 4:30-6pm Poetry workshop for middle school teachers

The workshop participants will be introduced to and write persona poems related to a history subject they have been exploring in class. Participants will select a history figure being studied and write an acrostic poem informing their "classmates" about the historical figure's importance to the historical event being studied, ie. American Revolution or Civil Rights, for which examples include Montgomery Bus Boycott, and segregation.
