Hurricane and Storm Preparedness Tips

On Campus Residents: Listen and follow the instructions of your RHD, RAs and Public Safety, if they tell you to leave, do so. Listen to local radio stations, watch new reports or go online for up-to-date storm information. **Stay inside the Residence Halls, away from windows, unless you are told to evacuate.** Keep the windows, doors and curtains closed during the storm.

Off Campus Residents: Listen to local radio stations, watch new reports or go online for up-to-date storm information. Know where your local shelter site is and what evacuation route you take to get there. **Stay inside your home, away from windows and doors.** Keep the windows, doors and curtains closed during the storm.

Gather Supplies:

- ✓ First Aid Kit
- ✓ Bottled water (enough for 3 days)
- ✓ Canned food (non-perishable, enough for 3 days)
- ✓ Manual can opener
- ✓ Flashlight and extra batteries
- ✓ Battery-powered radio for updates
- ✓ Keep all of your important documents in a re-sealable zipper storage bag in a safe place
- ✓ Blanket
- ✓ Toiletries
- ✓ Personal medication
- ✓ Have your important information ready at a moment's notice.

Be aware: The "Eye" of the storm is deceptive; the storm is not over. The worst part of the storm will happen once the eye passes over and the winds blow from the opposite direction. Trees, shrubs, buildings, and other objects damaged by the first winds can be broken or destroyed by secondary winds.

Driving Off Campus: Stay away from flood waters and watch for flash flood alerts. If you come upon a flooded road, turn around and go another way. If you are caught on a flooded road and waters are rising rapidly around you, get out of the car immediately and climb to higher ground. Stay off the roads if you can.
