2012 - 2013 Program Outcomes Report

The following is a report of program outcomes for the Department of Counseling and Development for the following semesters: Summer 2012, Fall 2012, Spring 2013. This information is based on records kept at the programmatic level, and on student responses to a telephone survey of graduates conducted in November, 2013 (51% Response Rate).

Total Program Enrollment (both campuses):

Clinical Mental Health Counseling – 125
School Counseling – 69

Average Student / Faculty Ratio:

LIU Post Campus – 8.76 students for each faculty member
LIU Brentwood Campus – 7.95 students for each faculty member

Program Graduates Over the Past Year (both campuses):

School Counseling – 33
