Description: The Support and Skills Program will meet for 2 hours on seven Saturdays. This program will focus on providing leisure, communication, and social skills to children with Autism and their siblings. During the first hour, children with Autism are provided individualized skill instruction while siblings attend a support group, where siblings will be able to discuss issues related to having a sibling with a disability and they will be provided with information on appropriate interactions with their sibling. During the second hour, both children will meet and participate in an inclusive recreation program.
