## POETRY CENTER LIU POST

Deadline: February 20, 2013 (for receipt)

Awards: The John and Agnes McCarten Memorial Award of \$100 to an undergraduate poet.

\$75 for the best poems in the following categories: graduate; faculty/staff; alumni.

Also short fiction award—see details below.

**Eligibility:** Any original, previously unpublished poem no longer than 50 lines.

Rules: NO IDENTIFICATION SHOULD BE PLACED ON THE MANUSCRIPT.

All poems, typed one to a page, should be placed together in a single envelope.

No more than three poems per entrant.

On the envelope, write your name, address (both dorm and home), and status at LIU Post (undergraduate, graduate, faculty/staff, or alumnus/alumna).

Bring the envelope to the Poetry Contest Box in the English Department on the second floor of Humanities Hall, or mail to:

Winners will be notified by mail. Others will be notified of the winners if they include a self-addressed, stamped envelope. An award may be withheld in a category if, in the judges' determination, none of the submitted poems is deserving of a prize. No entries will be returned, nor their receipt acknowledged.

## **Short Fiction Competition**

Entries must be original, previously unpublished short stories. Manuscripts must not exceed 3 pages typed and must be double-spaced in Times New Roman, 12pt. Prize will be \$50.

**Judges:** English Department faculty

The 47th annual Poetry Awards Night will be held on Wednesday, April 10, 2013. **JANE AUGUSTINE** and **MICHAEL HELLER** will read their poems and present the awards. The winning poems will be printed in the evening's program, and winners will read their poems.
