

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

During this five-day intensive, you'll have the opportunity to work closely with faculty who bring real-world experience to the classroom. You'll hone your skills and master audition techniques that will serve you well during your college auditions and beyond.

As part of the program, you'll:

- Study with Broadway professional David Hugo ("Les Miserables," "Jekyll & Hyde").
- Take classes in dance, singing and acting.
- Go on a field trip to a Broadway show, including a backstage tour with cast members.
- Perform in an end-of-session showcase.

Dr. Cara Gargano is chair of the Department of Theatre, Film, Dance and Arts Management and professor of dance and theatre at LIU Post. Dr. Gargano studied at the New York School of Ballet and later taught at the school. She has worked in theatre, opera and musical comedy, and as a ballet dancer with companies like the Milwaukee Repertory Theater and U.S. Terpsichore Ballet Co. Her choreography received warm reviews from The New York Times and has been presented here in the United States and in Europe.



David Hugo teaches freshman acting and musical theater acting courses in the Theater, Film, Dance & Arts Management Department at LIU Post. He has performed regionally; on national tours; and on Broadway in shows such as “Jekyll and Hyde,” “Iolanthe,” “Into the Woods” and “Les Miserables.” His 12-year run with “Les Miserables” included portraying Grantaire in the final Broadway cast. A member of Actor’s Equity Association, he holds a B.F.A. in acting from Syracuse University and an M.A. in theatre from LIU Post.
