

The Suffolk/LIU ExpressSuccess Program will provide Suffolk students with the ability to be simultaneously accepted into selected programs of study offered by both institutions.

Suffolk County Community College and Long Island University (LIU) have entered into a partnership that will allow incoming Suffolk students to conveniently get on track toward earning a bachelor's degree from Long Island University.

Students can choose from more than a dozen degree-granting programs. Suffolk students who are enrolled in these programs and maintain a qualifying grade point average (GPA), and who are accepted into Suffolk's Honors Program and Phi Theta Kappa, will be eligible for transfer scholarships to LIU ranging up to \$19,000 per year. LIU will also provide on-site academic counseling for Suffolk students during their first two years, as well as access to the LIU library system and other LIU campus-based facilities.

## ExpressSuccess Scholarship Opportunities

---

The Suffolk/LIU ExpressSuccess program offers a number of scholarship opportunities for transferring to LIU.

### Grade Point Average (GPA) Academic/Transfer Scholarship

3.81 - 4.00	\$11,500
3.50 - 3.80	\$11,000
3.21 - 3.49	\$9,500
3.00 - 3.20	\$9,000
2.99 and below to 2.50	\$8,500

In addition, there are a number of opportunities for Suffolk-LIU joint admissions students to earn scholarships and/or receive financial assistance. Some examples of these opportunities are:

### Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship

This \$3,000 per year award is available to transfer students who are members of Phi Theta Kappa at Suffolk.

### Honors College Scholarship

This \$2,000 per year award is available to transfer students who are admitted into the Honors College at LIU and remain in good academic standing.

### LIU Access Award

This \$2,500 per year award is available to 20 transfer students who demonstrate financial need via the FAFSA and packaging process.

## FAQs

### What is Joint Admissions?

Joint Admissions is an agreement between Suffolk County Community College and LIU that allows you to start planning your entire four-year degree program as soon as you begin your education at Suffolk.

### What are the benefits of the Suffolk/LIU ExpressSuccess Program?

1. Students will have the benefit of being taught by renowned faculty at Suffolk and LIU.
2. Students will be able to complete a four-year degree with the benefit of two outstanding institutions without undue financial burden.
3. Students will enjoy the benefits of small classes at Suffolk and LIU.
4. Students have access to the resources at both institutions for research, cultural events, and athletic facilities, as well as other campus resources and facilities.

### Must I complete an admissions application for Suffolk County Community College and Long Island University to be accepted into the program?

An addendum admissions application, along with the completion of a Suffolk application, will be used by both institutions.

### Will I receive an acceptance letter from both institutions?

Yes, students will receive an acceptance letter from both institutions.

### Are there specific academic requirements?

Yes, you are required to graduate from Suffolk with a minimum GPA of 2.5 and either an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree.

### Are there any costs involved?

No. There are no costs for participation in the Joint Admissions Program.

### Will I be assigned a Long Island University counselor/advisor while I am attending Suffolk County Community College?

Yes, Long Island University will assign an advisor/counselor while you are in attendance at Suffolk.
