Annual awards up to **\$7,000** are renewable each year as long as the student maintains his or her enrollment status and a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS[†]

Domestic Graduate Students

- Minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA (on 4.0 scale) in all previous undergraduate or graduate coursework.
- Test score requirements may apply to certain disciplines as determined by your academic department.
- Some disciplines may require additional requirements, such as a portfolio or interview.

International Graduate Students

- Minimum 7.5 IELTS or 100 IBT TOEFL (250 CBT or 600 PBT)
- International Admissions reserves the right to request a NACES member course-by-course evaluation.

HOW TO APPLY

Prospective students must submit the attached application and have formally applied to LIU Post using the online application at www.liu.edu/post/apply by **July 1, 2013**. Late applications will be reviewed on a funds-available basis. Students may apply for this scholarship before completing the online application.
