Find out how good you really are. LIU Post provides a limited number of annual Queens Borough Scholarships to new undergraduate freshmen and transfer students entering each Fall semester. Annual awards range from \$1,000 - \$5,000 and are renewable for up to a total of four years for new freshmen and three years for transfer students.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS[†]

Freshmen

Minimum 82-85, "B" average, or 3.0 cumulative GPA (on 4.0 scale) in all previous school work

Transfer

Minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA in all previous college work

International

Minimum TOEFL score of 525

HOW TO APPLY

Prospective students must submit the attached application and have formally applied to LIU Post by **January 15, 2013**. Students need not be accepted to LIU Post before submitting the application. Scholarship applicants may only be considered for one of these awards. Preference will be given to students who complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) by **March 1, 2013**. [†]Awards are limited. Applicants must meet all qualifications and deadlines in order to be eligible for consideration. Renewal is contingent upon the recipient maintaining a 3.0 cumulative GPA and earning 12 credits each semester. Students must be billed the flat undergraduate rate of tuition. Additional academic and need-based scholarships and grants may be available to qualified students. The University reserves the right to restrict the awarding of multiple grants and scholarships. Total scholarship assistance cannot exceed annual tuition and may not be used for graduate coursework.
