As part of LIU-Hudson's continuing effort to provide you excellent career preparation, we will be offering the state-mandated workshop in Harassment, Bullying, Cyberbullying and Discrimination in Schools, Prevention and Intervention. Completion of the DASA (Dignity Act) workshop is required for New York State certification as of July 2013.

To make fulfillment of this certification requirement as convenient for you as possible, we are offering the 6 hour workshop in a 3 hour face-to-face plus 3 hour online format. The face-to-face sessions will be held on Sat., July 20, 2013 and Sat., July 27, 2013. Both sessions will last from 9 A.M.-12 P.M. and will be given on the Westchester Campus. Participants who anticipate applying for certification at the end of the summer will need to select one of those two dates to attend the face-to-face portion of the training. After the face-to-face meeting, participants will have one week to complete the online segment. Following successful completion of all 6 hours, the candidate will be issued a "Certificate of Completion." A copy of the certificate will be kept in your permanent records for six years.
