Long Island University at Riverhead Graduates 75 at Commencement

Fifty-one education majors and 24 students of homeland security management graduated from Long Island University at Riverhead on May 11 at a ceremony and dinner at The Vineyard in Aquebogue. This is the third commencement exercises for Long Island University's Riverhead location, since it opened in 2006. Next

year, undergraduate degrees will be conferred as well, as the institution's first bachelor's degree candidates complete their studies.

Members of the Class of 2010 were addressed by Dr. David J. Steinberg, president of Long Island University, and Edward Shorin, chancellor of Long Island University at Riverhead. Dr. Steinberg noted that a master's degree can be expected to result in better pay, opportunity for advancement and job security in difficult economic times – but said its value goes beyond compensation.

"The real value of your advanced degree," he said, "is not to be found in a monetary boost or a step increase in rank. It is in your pursuit of the additional knowledge implicit in a

master's degree that such knowledge will allow you to become a better professional and more important, a fuller, more humane individual."

Shorin, who also is a member of the University board of trustees, expressed admiration for students who had juggled work and family responsibilities while earning their degrees, and wished the graduates well.

"In a sense, it's as if all of us – loving family, friends and members of the University family – are all standing here on a dock, waving and cheering as you are about to depart on your continued life's journey," he said. "Perhaps the supplicating wishes of all of us might be best condensed and expressed with merely the two words – 'Bon Voyage.'"

Associate Provost Jennifer Browne, the chief administrator of Long Island University at Riverhead, presided along with Dr. Paul Forestell, provost of the C.W. Post Campus of Long Island University and Long Island University at Riverhead; Dr. Jeffrey Kane, University vice president for academic affairs; and Dr. Vincent Henry, director of the Long Island University Homeland Security Management Institute.
