



**The President David J. Steinberg Endowed Undergraduate Fellowship Program**  
Program Application

**PROGRAM DESCRIPTION**

Fellowships are to permit outstanding but financial needy undergraduate students the opportunity to study and travel abroad in their junior year. Initially each shall carry a stipend of \$20,000 per annum. Normally the awards shall go to rising juniors, and every applicant must present in his or her application a statement of how the applicant plans to spend his or her academic year. Successful applicants may choose to study at a program operated by Long Island University abroad, or at other credit-bearing programs or when appropriate, some other artistic or learning context deemed meritorious by the selection committee. All Steinberg Fellows will be expected to submit a written report chronicling their experiences abroad.

**PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS**

**ESSAY**

In no more than 1,000 words clearly outline your plans if awarded this fellowship. If you intend to study at a university overseas, discuss the country and institution of preference and how these particulars are related to your plans. If you plan to undertake independent study, engage in a creative or research project, humanitarian efforts or extensive travel; please provide a detailed explanation of your plans and goals. Be sure to establish how your education and training have prepared you to undertake the work that you propose. The committee will use the information you provide to assess your ability to undertake and complete the plan of study that you propose. It is to your advantage to provide as much significant, detailed information as you can in support of your application.

**REFERENCES**

Please provide two letters of recommendation from two faculty members (or professional people in your field) who know you well enough to assess your ability to complete the plans that you propose. One reference must be from the chair of your major department.
