Policy Name: Chemical Waste Disposal Policy

Purpose: To provide guidance for the disposal of chemical waste products.

Policy: The Environmental Protection Agency regulates the disposal of radioactive materials, pesticides, regulated medical waste, used electronic equipment, fluorescent and HID lamps, used oil and other toxic substances.

The University has contracts for waste disposal. Departments that require disposal of any item listed above must enlist the environmental services of a chemical waste disposal vendor under University contract, in accordance with campus chemical hygiene plan protocols, to ensure that the regulated substance is disposed of in accordance with all laws and regulations.

This Policy Applies to: All Departments

Procedure: Departments must send a written list of items that need disposal that include identifying the name of the item, the size and the quantity to Procurement and Sourcing Services
