

**Articulation Agreement
BETWEEN

Long Island University, hereafter referred to as LIU, is a not-for-profit educational corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of New York with its principal place of business located at 700 Northern Blvd Brookville, New York 11548.

[REDACTED], is an educational corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of _____ with its principal place of business located at _____.

Purpose of the Agreement

The purpose of this agreement is to establish the academic collaboration between [REDACTED] and Long Island University (LIU), for and on behalf of its [Post, Brooklyn] Campus in [Brookville, Brooklyn] New York. The main objective of the collaboration is to [create a dual degree program], [promote the exchange of students] [expand the international content of the Programs of each institution].

Effective Date

This articulation agreement is effective upon final signature, and will be implemented beginning with the [REDACTED] semester 201[REDACTED].

Admissions Criteria

The Admissions criteria is more fully described in **Attachment A**. Selection of a candidate by [REDACTED] is not a guarantee that the candidate will be granted admission to LIU or the [Dual] Degree Program. Candidates will be held to the same rigorous admissions standards as other applicants, and final decisions will be solely at the discretion of LIU and [REDACTED].

A detailed description of the program and course requirements and equivalencies is annexed hereto as Schedule B.

Admission to the [INSERT LIU Program] will be based on academic qualifications including grade point average, courses taken, and TOEFL or TSE scores.

Transfer of Credits

This articulation agreement confirms that [_____] students who successfully complete [two/three] years in their respective programs in [Insert Program] will be able to transfer with [junior] status into the appropriate [Insert Degree] degree program/accelerated [Insert Degree] Degree Program at LIU [Post, Brooklyn] in [Insert Program]. Credits from [_____]’s programs will transfer to LIU [Post, Brooklyn] as stipulated in Appendix A of this document and completed credit will be applied to the appropriate LIU degree program. Completion of the degree at LIU [Post, Brooklyn] in [one/two/three] years is dependent upon the evaluation of possible general education transfer credits which are more fully described in the attached *Course Equivalency Tables*. LIU will confer a degree upon successful completion of the stated degree requirements.

[Transfer] students are accepted into the LIU [Post, Brooklyn] [INSERT LIU PROGRAM, i.e., Fine Arts] program may be awarded up to [] credits towards LIU [Post, Brooklyn] [course] requirements. Whether or not the degree can be completed at LIU [Post, Brooklyn] in [one/two/three] years is entirely dependent on the number of credits evaluated to transfer. Each student’s academic record will be assessed individually to ascertain how many semesters of residence at LIU [Post, Brooklyn] will be needed to complete the degree program. An evaluation of transferrable credits will be available to students prior to registering at LIU [Post, Brooklyn].

Conditions

International students participating in the above program will be governed by and must adhere to the same regulations and performance standards that pertain to other international students and international visitors, including the policies, regulations, laws and visa requirements of the host country and institution.

Tuition, Fees and Charges

Accepted and enrolled [_____] students will be directly responsible for all tuition charges, fees, and residential room and board charges outlined in the attached LIU [Post, Brooklyn] Schedule of Tuition and Fees for 201[]-201[]. See Schedule C.

University policy requires all students who reside on campus to have health insurance. International students will be automatically billed for the university-sponsored health insurance plan, or its equivalent on their bursar account.

There will be no monetary exchange between LIU and _____. Each institution will collect the appropriate tuition and other fees from each student for the period of time which the student is enrolled in that institution.

All tuition and fee schedules are annexed hereto as Exhibit C.

All travel, living and academic expenses (including room and board) other than tuition shall be borne by each Participant. These expenses include, but are not limited to: Food, the Participant's living expenses during the academic year, the Participant's living expenses during extended academic recess (*i.e.* holidays, winter and spring break periods, etc., passport expenses, excess baggage shipment and storage, repatriation, international and domestic travel, and such personal expenses as telephone charges, books, etc.

Term

This agreement will remain in force for one academic year, unless terminated earlier pursuant to mutual consent or upon 90 days' written notice by one of the parties to the other. The agreement may only be modified or renewed by a written memorandum signed by both institutions. In the event that the agreement is terminated mid-semester: Those registered students may complete their current semester of study. In the event that either institution loses its accreditation, this agreement will terminate immediately.

MUTUAL RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Each institution shall designate an individual who will serve as the liaison officer for this agreement, and be responsible for coordinating the specific aspects of the program. The coordinator will be responsible for promoting the affiliation to prospective and current students by providing information to the university admissions staff, career planning and placement officers, and all student advisors.
2. Neither party shall discriminate against any employee, applicant, or student because of race, color, creed, sex, religion, marital status, disability, veteran status or national origin.
3. Each party warrants that it has, or its personnel have or will obtain and maintain all necessary and relevant licenses, permissions, certifications, authorizations, registrations and approvals.
4. Each party shall perform its respective obligations hereunder as an independent contractor. Nothing contained in this Articulation Agreement shall create any agency, partnership, association or joint venture between the parties hereto. Neither party shall have the right or authority to create any obligation or responsibility, express or implied, on behalf of or in the sake of the other party, or to bind the other party contractually in any manner whatsoever. Under no circumstances, as a result of this Articulation Agreement, shall any officer, agent, employee or representative of one party be considered an officer, agent, employee or representative of the other party.
5. The U.S. Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act and LIU's rules governing student records, privacy and access rights shall apply to all enrolled student records.
6. Should a student be removed, suspended, or expelled from this Program, the removing institution's disciplinary rules shall apply.
7. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws

of the State of New York, excluding any rule or principle of conflict of laws that might refer the interpretation or construction of this Agreement to the laws of any other jurisdiction.

8. LIU and [REDACTED] will jointly market this program, and any and all publications or advertisements promoting this program must be approved in writing by LIU and [REDACTED]. The use of either party's trademarks, trade names, logos, copyrights, patents or any other intellectual property in the furtherance of this Agreement or otherwise, without the express written consent of the owner, is strictly prohibited.

Indemnification

LIU and [REDACTED] agree to indemnify and hold each other harmless, as well as their trustees, officers, employees, agents, and representatives from and against any and all claims, demands, actions, settlements, or judgments, including attorney's fees and litigation expenses, based upon or arising out of the activities described in this Agreement, to the extent that such claims, demands, actions, settlements or judgments are occasioned by the negligence, actions or omissions of LIU or [REDACTED] their agents, servants, employees or students.
