

2024-2025 Foreign Income Review

Starting with the 2024-2025 FAFSA all US tax filers, and non-filers, will have their 2022 tax information verified automatically with the IRS. This form is to verify 2022 income information for students, parents or spouses who earned foreign income and filed with a tax authority other than the IRS, or non-tax filers that would have filed with a tax authority other than the IRS, if they were to file.

A separate form should be submitted for each contributor who falls within this category. All individuals must complete section A, either section B or C depending on their tax filing status, and then section D.
