Class of 2013 Placement (Confirmed through 1/1/14)

142 Graduates (78.5%) employed or seeking employment **confirmed** through survey, direct contact with graduate and/or through employer

- 76.8% (109/142) employed in community pharmacy
- 16.9% (24/142) employed in hospital pharmacy
- (includes 7.7% [11/142] in post-graduate residencies)
- 2.8% (4/142) employed in pharmaceutical-related industry
- 1.4% (2/142) other pharmacy-related employment
- 2.1% (3/142) unemployment actively seeking placement

(148 graduates (81.8%) current employment status confirmed. 6 not seeking employment due to marriage, children or other personal decision)

Class of 2013 Academic Honors

- 39.44% (71/180) graduating on-time students received Latin honors (GPA of 3.50 or greater)
- 9.44% (17/180) graduated *magna cum laude* (GPA of 3.80 or greater)
 - 12.22% (22/180) graduated *summa cum laude* (GPA of 3.70 or greater)
 - 17.78% (32/180) graduated *cum laude* (GPA of 3.50 or greater)
